- How to arrange pictures on your web page.
- Responsive web design.
- Website navigation and other links.

## JavaScript:

- What a variable is and how to use it.
- How to make your program easy to understand by using functions.
- The power of repeating with loops.
- Your webpage is a kind of document.
- When to act in the event the mouse or keyboard is used.
